Zuo Wenquan, born in Gansu Province, China in 1991, is an artist who has seamlessly integrated art into his life. Trained in oil painting at the Chinese National Academy of Arts, Zuo Wenquan's artwork is characterized by his unique portrayal and incorporation of flowers and crows.
